Fire Official's Report:

John Austin gave the fire official report for March 2017. There were 3 fire investigations for the month.

Vehicle Maintenance Report:

Mr. Troy DePrince gave the vehicle maintenance report. Colonial Manor have several vehicles that are being serviced. Sensors were changed in Greenfields aerial for flow and is still being worked on for complete resolution. Auto charger will be changed as soon as authorization is given.

Purchasing has given authorization for general maintenance on truck repairs.


