Royal (East Greenwich) is undergoing some type of work/renovation. The individual investigating the issue has not returned to the site to examine what was done. He expects the owners will receive a letter about violations. Rich shared that the mud/dirt issue at the road site of the e-commerce building seems somewhat improved. Ed responded by saying there is a lot dirt and mud at the RR crossing (close to the car wash) where there is a bump in the road.
