INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PUMP STATIONS #4 & #6 REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS

Construction of upgrades and improvements to Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations No. 4 located at Crown Point Rd. & Red Bank Ave. and No.6 located at Prince St & Warren Ave at a project cost of \$1,386,400 were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by ensuring the safe collection and discharge of wastewater to the Gloucester County Treatment Plant for residents and businesses in West Deptford Township.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
